The Espectacular Concert brings the best mariachi groups from around the world to Tucson. A high point of the musical extravaganza is Mariach Vargas de Tecalitlán - el mejor mariachi del mundo. As a 5th generation mariachi they offer an eclectic assortment of traditional Mexican songs mixed with incredible compositions, light classical melodies and an amazing performance style. Also gracing our stage for their 23th consecutive year is Mariachi Los Camperos de Nati Cano. Over the past 40 years this group has honed their finesse and accuracy delighting audiences with demanding musical compositions. Mariachi Los Camperos de Nati Cano is credited with taking the mariachi tradition from the streets of Mexico to some of the most prestigious concert halls in the world.
